Dr. Ziviani forwarded 2024 invoices to ASHRAE and requested ASHRAE staff to release funds from Purdue's account at ASHRAE. Dr. Allouche highlighted the risk of the 2031 ICR not occurring due to delinquent account from the US. The World Refrigeration Day was a very successful event.

	 Purdue Herrick Conference is scheduled for July 12 to 16, 2026. Bracing for lower attendance due to notification from Purdue's international office that visa invitation letters cannot be issued by Herrick Laboratories staff alone. A strict vetting process will be implemented especially for speakers from China. USNC course ideas: <i>Dynamic Modeling and Control of Systems, Hightemperature Heat Pumps, Data Center Cooling</i> Dr. Craig Bradshaw and Dr. Stefan Elbel to coordinate on course outlines to straw poll among USNC members. Title and abstract for short courses by Thanksgiving 2025. Would like to finalize speakers by 2026 Winter Conference in Las Vegas, NV. 2031 ICR awarded to the US; almost 30 years after the last US-based conference in 2003. Location will be Marriott Marquis San Diego Marina in San Diego, CA. August 2 to 8, 2031; budget \$2 million. Chairs: Prof. Davide Ziviani (Purdue), Prof. Brian Fronk (PennState), Prof. Craig Bradshaw (UIUC). Prof. Eckhard Groll will be the honorary chair. 2025 TPTPR had about 90 attendees and 43 papers presented, selected out of 67 abstracts. There were 2 plenary sessions and 4 speakers: Prof. Vikrant Aute, Dr. Mark McLinden, Prof. Mark Shiflett, and Prof. Claudio Zilio. The small nature of the conference allowed better and closer interaction between attendees. Timing and organization of next edition of the conference is yet undecided.



The most recent USNC/IIR financial statement as of 2/10/2025 is attached to this report. In summary, the financial status is as follows:

As of 1/31/2025, the USNC/IIR organization had total net assets and equity in the amount of \$36,345.26. This includes the \$10k contribution from ASHRAE, but missing NIST and DOE.

USNC/IIR 2020 dues (2020-2021)

- ASHRAE: \$10k received on 7/01/2020 for 2020 dues
- NIST: \$10k received on 1/21/2021 for 2020 dues (Sep. 1, 2020 Aug. 31, 2021)
- DOE: \$24,000 received on 6/30/2021 for 2020 dues (Oct. 1, 2020 Sep. 30, 2021)

UNSC/IIR 2021 dues (2021-2022)

- DOE: \$24,000 Invoice for 2021 dues (Oct. 1, 2021 Sep. 30, 2022) was sent to ORNL on June 21, 2022 no payment received as of 5/31/2023. Brian Fricke and Kashif Nawaz stated that payment is now being processed.
